Sean McCray is the academic curriculum manager for The International School of Hospitality (TISOH) in Las Vegas, Nevada.

McCray joined TISOH in 2014 to review, revise and update curriculum content in collaboration with instructors and industry professionals to ensure students learn the cutting-edge skills needed to launch or advance their careers in hospitality.

McCray brings to TISOH a wealth of experience in continuing and adult education from his time as the manager and coordinator of The Learning Center at Western Kentucky University in Bowling Green, Kentucky.
